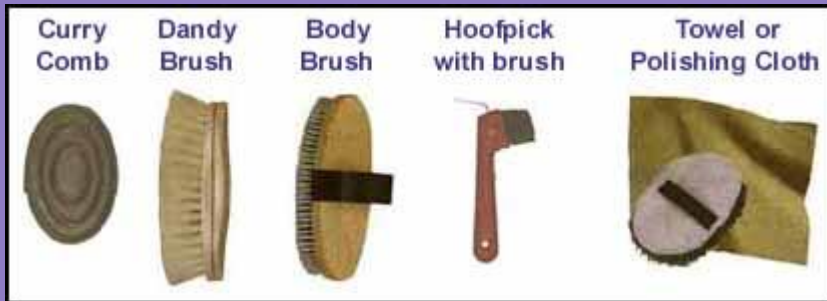
What is dressage?

A well balanced horse and rider

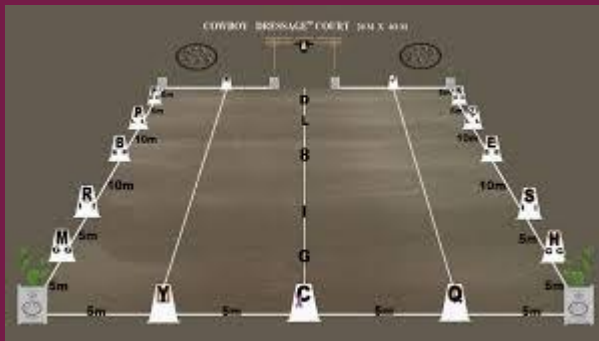
